

Vidalista Black: price without insurance? - in Australia

Vidalista Black: what is it and is it FDA approved?

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Overview snapshot and clinical traces

Vidalista Black is a high potency erectile dysfunction product that contains tadalafil, a phosphodiesterase type 5 inhibitor. It is intended for adult males diagnosed with erectile dysfunction to assist in achieving and maintaining an erection when sexually stimulated.

Beyond ED, tadalafil is prescribed in different dosing schedules for other conditions under medical supervision. Lower daily doses are commonly used for benign prostatic hyperplasia. For pulmonary arterial hypertension, specialist formulations and dose plans are required and should not be substituted with ED tablets without specialist input.

- Main indication: erectile dysfunction.
- Tadalafil is the active ingredient.
- Featured strength on this page: 80 mg tablet. This is a high strength and should only be used if explicitly prescribed by a clinician.
- Other clinical uses: BPH at low daily doses; PAH with specialist products and real time monitoring.

Many men start with lower strengths such as 5, 10 or 20 mg for on demand use. Discuss the appropriate starting regimen with your prescriber and consult the [Dose amount and directions](#) subsection. How tadalafil functions

Tadalafil curbs PDE5 activity. When a man is sexually aroused, this inhibition increases levels of cyclic GMP in penile tissues, leading to relaxation of smooth muscle and increased blood inflow into the penis. Effects can persist for up to 36 hours in many users. Tadalafil does not cause an erection without sexual stimulation.

Instructions for dosing

Please follow the directions from your healthcare provider. For on demand use, take one dose about 30 to 60 minutes before sexual activity, swallowing the tablet whole with water. Only split a tablet if the product is scored and your pharmacist confirms it is safe to do so.

- Strength selection: although this document discusses 80 mg tablets, many men achieve benefit with 10-20 mg taken as needed; daily low dose regimens are typically 2.5-5 mg.
- Food subtle intercommunications can reinforce culture.: the tablet may be taken with or without food; very high fat meals can delay onset.

- Maximum frequency: do not take tadalafil more than once every 24 hours for on demand dosing.
- Daily option: some patients are prescribed a small daily dose for continuous effect and for symptoms of BPH.
- Avoid excessive alcohol and grapefruit products as they can interact and increase undesirable effects; see [Interaction among drugs](#) please refer to the details.

If indirect effects are problematic or if the dose feels too strong or too weak, contact your prescriber for a review. Revert to [Navigate to the page top](#).

Safety measures

- Intended only for males aged 18 years and older. Not for use in women or children.
- Tell your doctor if you have any history of heart disease, liver or kidney issues, bleeding disorders, stomach ulcers, Peyronie disease, or eye disorders such as retinitis pigmentosa or a history of nonarteritic anterior ischemic optic neuropathy.
- Obtain medical advice before starting, stopping, or altering the dose.
- Do not implement in this case you have experienced an allergic reaction to tadalafil or any component of the formulation.
- If you experience dizziness or visual disturbance, avoid driving or using machines until you are fully recovered.

When this should not be used

- Concurrent use of nitrates or nitric oxide donors in any form due to a risk of severe low blood pressure.
- Riociguat and other soluble guanylate cyclase stimulators should not be taken together with this medication.
- Conditions where sexual activity is medically unsafe, for example recent myocardial infarction, unstable angina, recent stroke, or uncontrolled severe hypertension.

- Advanced hepatic disease unless under specialist supervision.
- Severe renal impairment may necessitate dose adjustment and close observation and tracking.
- Known hypersensitivity to tadalafil or an excipient in the tablet.

Alpha blocker combinations increase the risk of symptomatic hypotension. If co prescription is necessary, doctors normally use the lowest possible doses and monitor blood pressure. Drug intercommunication effects

Provide your prescriber with a full list of medications, herbal products, and supplements before taking tadalafil.

- Nitrates and nitric oxide donors: absolute contraindication due to risk of severe hypotension.
- Riociguat: contraindicated.
- Other erectile dysfunction or PAH agents such as sildenafil, vardenafil or avanafil: generally avoid combining unless under specialist direction.
- Strong CYP3A4 inhibitors like ketoconazole, itraconazole or clarithromycin: can increase tadalafil concentrations.
- Strong enzyme inducers such as rifampicin, carbamazepine or phenytoin: may reduce tadalafil exposure and effect.
- Alpha blockers including doxazosin or tamsulosin: additive blood pressure lowering may occur; medical supervision recommended.
- Some calcium channel blockers and other vasodilators may amplify hypotensive effects.
- Cimetidine therapy can increase tadalafil levels in the body.

Avoid grapefruit and grapefruit juice. Limit alcohol to minimise the risk of dizziness or drops in blood pressure. For absolute do not use situations see [Use is contraindicated in these cases](#). Navigate back to [To the uppermost part of the page](#).

Extra effects

Most adverse reactions are mild to moderate and resolve without treatment. Seek timely medical care for serious or persistent reactions.

- Cranial ache along with facial reddening and nasal congestion occur commonly., indigestion, back pain, and lightheadedness.
- Gastrointestinal complaints: nausea or diarrhea may occur.
- Visual symptoms: a blue or green tinge to vision or blurred sight has been reported in some users.
- Urinary complaints such as painful urination are uncommon.
- Serious reactions: chest pain, collapse, sudden hearing or vision loss, allergic reactions with swelling or breathing difficulty, or an erection lasting more than 4 hours (priapism). Call emergency services immediately if any of these occur.

Not taken at scheduled time causing overdose death

- On demand use: there is no fixed daily schedule. If you miss taking a tablet before planned activity do not double the next dose.
- Daily regimens: if you miss a scheduled daily dose, take it when remembered unless the next scheduled dose is near; do not take two doses together.
- Overdosing: do not exceed the prescribed dose. In case of suspected overdose contact the Poisons Information Centre on 13 11 26 for non urgent advice in Australia, or call 000 for severe emergencies such as fainting or severe chest pain.

Principles of proper a storage facility serves as a repository for goods awaiting use.

- Keep this item beyond the sight and reach of children and pets.
- Store in a cool, dry place, ideally below 25 C, protected from moisture and direct light.
- Leave tablets in their original blister pack or container until use.

- Do not freeze and do not use after the expiry date printed on the pack.

Dispose of unwanted or expired medicines via an approved pharmacy return scheme.

Other care options and related therapies

If tadalafil is unsuitable, plan B routes include other PDE5 inhibitors, non pill therapies, and specialist interventions. Choice is guided by speed of onset desired, duration required, concomitant medicines, tolerability and cost.

- Sildenafil (brand example Viagra and generics): onset 30-60 minutes; effect around 4 to 6 hours; often lower cost.
- Avanafil (Spedra): faster onset for many users, often 15-30 minutes; duration about 4-6 hours.
- Vardenafil (Levitra and generics): similar onset to sildenafil; some users report different side effect profile.
- Other tadalafil brands and generics such as Cialis and generics: same active ingredient, with on demand doses commonly 10-20 mg and long duration up to 36 hours.
- Non tablet options: vacuum erection devices, intracavernosal injections (for example alprostadil), intraurethral suppositories, psychosexual therapy, and in selected cases surgical implants.

Prices in the Australian currency (AUD)

Retail prices vary widely by brand, pharmacy, pack size, and whether a telehealth provider or discount scheme is used. The figures below are approximate private prices and can change over time.

- Generic sildenafil 50-100 mg: approximately AUD 1.00 to 3.50 per tablet.
- Generic tadalafil 20 mg: roughly AUD 1.50 to 6.00 per tablet, depending on pack size.
- Avanafil (Spedra) medication 50-200 mg: commonly around AUD 12 to 30 per tablet.

- Vardenafil (Levitra or generic) 10-20 mg: about AUD 8 to 20 per tablet.
- Brand Cialis 20 mg: typically AUD 18 to 35 per tablet.
- High strength tadalafil products such as 80 mg tablets (Vidalista Black) may be less commonly stocked. When available, expect prices to reflect the higher milligram content and specialist sourcing; approximate private cost might be AUD 7 to 20 per tablet depending on supplier. Some pharmacies will provide equivalent total milligrams using several lower strength tablets instead of a single high strength pill.
- Daily tadalafil 5 mg: monthly private costs often range from about AUD 15 to 70 depending on brand and pack quantity.

Cost saving strategies include asking for generic versions, buying larger packs where appropriate, or using pharmacy discount programs. Note that erectile dysfunction treatment is generally not subsidised on the PBS, while PAH treatments may qualify for PBS subsidy under specialist criteria. Move back to [Navigate to at the top](#).

The legal framework in Australia

- Scheduling: tadalafil is a Schedule 4 medication in Australia and is prescription only, regulated by the Therapeutic Goods Administration.
- Prescription requirement: a valid Australian prescription is needed to obtain tadalafil from community pharmacies; telehealth consultations may be used when appropriate.
- PBS listings: ED use is generally not PBS subsidised. Specialist tips such as PAH may be PBS listed under authority prescriptions.
- Advertising rules: direct to consumer promotion of prescription medicines is highly restricted throughout Australia.
- Personal importation: under the TGA Personal Import Plan an individual may import up to a three month supply for personal use, normally with evidence of a valid prescription. Importation should not be for resale and must comply with Australian Border Force rules.
- Age limits: intended for adult males 18 years and older; keep medicines away from children.

Concise facts

- Indication: primarily erectile dysfunction; also used for BPH and PAH in specialist regimens.
- Typical onset and duration: onset around 30 to 60 minutes with effects lasting up to 36 hours for many users.
- Mechanism: requires sexual stimulation to work; it does not produce an erection without arousal.
- Avoid amalgamating with nitrates or riociguat and do not mix with other ED medicines unless under specialist advice.
- Limit alcohol and avoid grapefruit products due to possible risks of people relating to one another.
- Seek urgent help for chest pain, sudden loss of vision or hearing, or an erection lasting longer than 4 hours.
