Viagra is the trade name for sildenafil, a drug that belongs to the phosphodiesterase type 5 (PDE5) inhibitor group. When a man becomes sexually aroused, the nitric oxide-cGMP signaling pathway causes relaxation of the smooth muscle in penile blood vessels. Sildenafil helps maintain that relaxation by preventing PDE5 from breaking down cGMP, which increases blood flow to the penis and supports an erection when sexual stimulation is present.

Sildenafil is prescribed primarily for erectile dysfunction (ED) in adult men. Some formulations and doses of sildenafil are also approved in the United States to treat pulmonary arterial hypertension, but dosing and clues that suggest differ. Sildenafil does not increase libido and will not produce an erection without sexual arousal. Take this item as directed (dosage instructions)

Below are common dosing guidelines. Your prescriber may recommend a different regimen based on your health, other medicines you take, and how you respond.

- Usual starting dose for most adult men: 50 mg taken about 30 to 60 minutes before sexual activity.
- Adjustable dose: Depending on efficacy and unintended effects, dose may be decreased to 25 mg or increased to 100 mg. Do not exceed 100 mg per single dose.
- Frequency: Take no more than one dose within a 24-hour period.

- Meals: A large or fatty meal can delay onset; take on an emptier stomach if you want a faster start.
- Avoid grapefruit and grapefruit juice while using sildenafil; they can significantly increase blood levels.
- Avoid heavy alcohol intake because it can impair performance and increase the chance of dizziness or low blood pressure.

People with reduced liver or kidney function, older adults, or those taking interacting medicines may be advised to start at 25 mg. Only split scored tablets if directed by a pharmacist and use a tablet splitter. When in doubt, follow your clinician's advice and consult [safety safeguards you should take](#).

Sildenafil can interact with an assortment of medicines and substances. Tell your prescriber and pharmacist about all prescription drugs, over-the-counter medicines, herbs, and supplements you use.

- Absolute contraindication: Nitrates (nitroglycerin, isosorbide dinitrate or mononitrate) and recreational nitrite "poppers" — combining these with sildenafil can cause a serious and full potentially life-threatening drop in blood pressure.
- Other ED therapies: Keep from combining. sildenafil with other PDE5 inhibitors or similar erectile agents on the same day unless explicitly instructed by your clinician.
- Antihypertensives and alpha-blockers: These can enhance blood pressure lowering effects; timing adjustments or dose changes may be needed.
- CYP3A4 inhibitors (for example ritonavir, cobicistat, ketoconazole, clarithromycin) can raise sildenafil exposure; strong inducers (for example rifampin, phenytoin, carbamazepine) can lower its effect.
- Soluble guanylate cyclase stimulators (for example riociguat) may have additive hypotensive effects and are generally not recommended with sildenafil.
- Grapefruit products: May increase sildenafil levels; avoid while taking this medicine.

Primary safety measures you should follow

- Heart conditions: Inform your prescriber if you have a history of heart attack, stroke, angina, arrhythmia, heart failure, or uncontrolled blood pressure.
- Vision and hearing: Rare cases of sudden vision loss or sudden hearing decrease have been reported. Stop the drug and seek immediate medical attention if these occur.
- Priapism: An erection lasting longer than 4 hours is a medical emergency — get urgent care to avoid permanent injury.
- Allergic reactions: Do not take sildenafil if you are allergic to it or any inactive ingredients in the tablet formulation.
- Older adults: May be more susceptible to dizziness and low blood pressure; a lower initial dose is often appropriate.
- Not approved for use in women or children for ED.

Who should not be given it?

- Anyone currently using nitrate medications for chest pain or recreational nitrites.
- People using another PDE5 inhibitor or other ED drugs on the same day unless instructed otherwise by a clinician.
- Those with a known hypersensitivity to sildenafil or any ingredient in the product.
- Concurrent use with riociguat is generally contraindicated because of additive hypotension.
- It is not approved for treating ED in women or children under 18.

Undesired effects

Most men tolerate sildenafil well. Off target effects tend to be mild and will vanish without external aid.

- Common side effect types: Headache episode plus facial flushing with nasal congestion, indigestion or heartburn, stomach upset, lightheadedness, and diarrhea.
- Scarcely seen but serious reactions: Severe allergic response, chest pain, sudden loss of hearing, significant visual disturbances (such as a change in color perception), fainting, or prolonged painful erection (see priapism under [primary cautionary measures](#)).

Stop taking sildenafil and seek immediate medical attention for chest pain, signs of anaphylaxis, sudden vision loss, severe dizziness, or an erection lasting more than 4 hours. For suspected having an overdose, refer to [a non fatal overdose](#).

Not taken at scheduled time

Sildenafil for ED is taken as needed at the time of anticipated sexual activity; there is no standing daily schedule for the as-needed regimen. Ensure at least 24 hours have elapsed since your last dose before taking another.

Overdose situation

Taking more than the recommended amount may cause significant effects such as severe dizziness, fainting, nausea, chest pain, or an abnormal heartbeat. If you suspect an overdose, call emergency services (911) or contact the Poison Help line at 1-800-222-1222 right away.

Storage room

- Keep at room temperature, about 20 to 25 degrees C (68 to 77 degrees F).
- Store away from excess moisture and direct light; avoid bathroom in computing, storage means the capacity to retain data over time..
- Keep tablets in their original container with the label intact and out of reach of children and pets.

Other options plus analogous medicines

If sildenafil is not suitable or gives inadequate results, several other treatment options exist. Discuss these with a clinician so the choice can be tailored to your health profile and preferences.

- Tadalafil (Cialis): Often starts within 30 to 60 minutes and can last up to 36 hours; available as once-daily low-dose options or on an as-needed basis.
- Vardenafil (Levitra, Staxyn): Comparable onset and duration to sildenafil; Staxyn is an orally disintegrating tablet for those who prefer not to swallow pills.
- Avanafil (Stendra): Some users report a faster onset (approximately 15 to 30 minutes) with a duration toward 6 hours for some individuals.
- Alprostadil (Caverject injection, Muse suppository): Non-oral diverse the alternative choices for men who cannot use PDE5 inhibitors; these require training and medical supervision.
- Device and behavioral options: Devices for vacuum-assisted erections, constriction rings, counseling for performance anxiety, and lifestyle changes such as improved diabetes control, quitting smoking, weight loss, and regular exercise.
