Tadagra is a trade name for a product containing tadalafil, a phosphodiesterase type 5 inhibitor commonly used to treat erectile dysfunction. It can also be prescribed in some

cases to relieve lower urinary tract symptoms associated with benign prostatic hyperplasia. This page is written with people in the United Kingdom in mind.

- Tadalafil is the drug's active ingredient and a PDE5 inhibitor.

Heads up: Tadalafil itself may not be a product licensed in the UK. When prescribed within the NHS or private clinics, UK pharmacies generally supply licensed tadalafil products, either as generic tadalafil or the brand Cialis.

How it operates and indicators

Tadalafil works by inhibiting the enzyme PDE5. With sexual stimulation this helps to maintain cyclic GMP in penile tissue, promoting smooth muscle relaxation and increased blood flow to support erection. For some men with lower urinary tract symptoms, tadalafil may relax smooth muscle in the prostate and bladder neck, easing symptoms.

Typical onset is around 30 minutes, and effects can persist for up to 36 hours in many users. Absorption is not significantly affected by food for most people. Dosing procedures and directions

Be sure to follow the instructions your prescriber gave. Swallow the tablets with a glass of water on hand. Do not alter the route of administration or attempt to crush, inject, or snort tablets.

- As-needed regimen (20 mg): take one tablet about 30 minutes before anticipated sexual activity. Do not take more than one dose in any given 24 hour period.
- Daily regimen: some people are prescribed tadalafil 2.5 mg or 5 mg once daily for continuous effect, including for BPH symptoms. The 20 mg tablet is not intended for daily dosing.
- Consistency: if on a daily dose, try to take it at the same time each day for best results.

Avoid excessive alcohol when using tadalafil as it can increase dizziness and reduce sexual performance. Grapefruit and grapefruit juice may raise tadalafil concentrations and should be avoided. If you have significant kidney or liver problems, dose changes or different treatments may be required - consult your clinician.

Potential deleterious effects and time sensitive cautions issued

Most unfavorable health effects are mild and go away on their own. Typical reactions include:

- Facial flush
- Dyspepsia symptoms or dyspeptic symptoms
- Headache flare
- Nose that runs and gets blocked
- Backache or muscle soreness
- Faintness accompanied by dizziness

Stop the medicine and seek immediate medical attention if you develop chest pain, fainting, sudden loss of vision or hearing, an allergic reaction (such as widespread rash, swelling of face or throat), or a painful erection lasting longer than 4 hours (priapism). You may also choose to [record any suspected adverse reactions.](#)

Social exchanges

Disclose all medicines, including over-the-counter and herbal preparations, to your healthcare professional. Foundational the quality of the networked exchange of ideas matters for trust. that deserve attention:

- Nitrates or nicorandil: using tadalafil with nitrates is strictly unsafe due to the risk of severe, life-threatening low blood pressure.
- Riociguat: concomitant use is not recommended.
- Alpha-blockers: may cause additive blood pressure lowering; careful vigilant monitoring and timing are needed.

- Strong CYP3A4 inhibitors: drugs such as ketoconazole, certain HIV protease inhibitors, and some macrolide antibiotics may increase tadalafil levels and require dose adjustments or avoidance.
- CYP3A4 inducers: agents like rifampicin, carbamazepine, and phenytoin may reduce tadalafil concentrations and effectiveness.
- Other erectile dysfunction medicines: keep these separate; do not combine them. PDE5 inhibitors without specialist advice.
- A drink containing ethanol and grapefruit: alcohol can worsen latent effects; grapefruit can increase tadalafil exposure.

Cautions before use

Discuss the following with your clinician before starting tadalafil:

- Kidney or liver dysfunction.
- Previous sudden vision or hearing loss; inherited retinal disorders such as retinitis pigmentosa.
- Low or uncontrolled high blood pressure, or symptoms suggestive of low blood pressure.
- Cardiac disease: angina, recent heart attack, heart failure, or if sexual activity is not advised due to cardiovascular risk.
- Penile structural problems such as Peyronie disease, or conditions that increase priapism risk.

Avoid driving or operating machinery if you experience dizziness. Tadalafil is licensed for adult men; it is not recommended for women or children under 18. Seek urgent care if you have an erection lasting more than 4 hours or sudden sensory loss.

Situations in which this treatment is not advised

- Concurrent use with nitrates (including recreational poppers) or nicorandil.
- Use with riociguat for pulmonary hypertension.

- Established allergy to tadalafil or to any tablet ingredient.
- Recent serious cardiovascular events (for example, myocardial infarction within the past 90 days, stroke within 6 months) or unstable cardiac conditions.
- Severe hepatic injury with impaired function, marked hypotension, or specific cardiac outflow or rhythm disorders as judged by a clinician.
- Hereditary retinal disorders such as retinitis pigmentosa.

Medication dose missed information and guidance

- As-needed dosing: if you miss taking a planned dose before sexual activity, you may take it when remembered but do not exceed one tablet in 24 hours.
- Daily dosing: if you forget a daily tablet, take it as soon as you remember unless the next scheduled dose is near. Do not take a double dose to cover a missed the medication dose.

Immediate actions for overdosed on medication and emergency situations

If you suspect you or someone else has taken an excessive amount of tadalafil, seek immediate medical advice. In the UK call NHS 111 for urgent medical guidance or attend the nearest emergency department. Take the medicine container or leaflet with you if possible.

Preservation and disposal

- Store tablets in their original packaging in a cool, dry place at or below normal room temperature. Avoid exposure to moisture and heat.
- Store all medications out of sight and out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not use after the expiry date marked on the packaging. Return unwanted or expired tablets to a pharmacy for safe disposal.

Other avenues and a rough price comparison data for the UK

Prices can vary depending on supplier, pack size, and whether products are branded or generic. The figures below are approximate private prices per tablet in GBP for reference only.

- Vardenafil (Levitra or generics): about 2.00 to 5.00 GBP per tablet.
- Branded Viagra (sildenafil 50-100 mg): around 5.00 to 8.00 GBP per tablet.
- Avanafil (Spedra) medication: typically 3.00 to 6.00 GBP per tablet.
- Generic tadalafil (10-20 mg as needed; 2.5-5 mg daily): roughly 1.00 to 3.00 GBP per tablet depending on strength and pack size.
- Branded Cialis (tadalafil): roughly 5.00 to 10.00 GBP per on-demand tablet; daily 5 mg tablets can be 2.00 to 6.00 GBP each in multipacks.
- Generic sildenafil (50-100 mg): commonly 0.20 to 1.00 GBP per tablet and widely available.

Non-pharmacological options include vacuum erection devices and psychosexual therapy, which may be suitable depending on the underlying cause. Discuss preferences, onset and duration needs, coexisting conditions, and side effect risks with your clinician when choosing between options.

Safe buying guidance based on United Kingdom status of legal compliance

- Tadalafil is a prescription-only medicine (POM) in the United Kingdom. A valid NHS or private prescription is required to lawfully obtain it.
- Over-the-counter option: only sildenafil 50 mg (Viagra Connect) may be supplied without a prescription under pharmacist supervision; tadalafil is not available OTC in the UK.
- Regulatory bodies: the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) oversees medicines. Pharmacies must be registered with the General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC) and should display their registration details.

- Importing: bringing prescription medicines into the UK without a prescription can result in seizure by Border Force. Unlicensed foreign-branded generics, such as Tadalafil from outside the UK, may not meet UK quality or labelling standards.
- Online services: choose UK-based online clinics that carry out a proper clinical assessment and show GPhC registration. Avoid websites that ship prescription medicines without a prescription or a consultation.
- Age and suitability: intended for adults 18 and over; not suitable for women or children unless directed by a specialist.

Before purchasing online, confirm the supplier's GPhC registration and ensure a suitable questionnaire or consultation is completed. Using medicines only as prescribed helps reduce risks. For more on legal issues, view the following notes. [the section in question.](#)

Top questions asked

- How long do the effects of tadalafil last? Many people experience benefit for up to 36 hours, though individual response varies.
- Can I split a 20 mg tablet? Some tablets are not designed to be split evenly. Follow prescriber instructions and product the facts.
- Can food intake affect tadalafil? A high-fat meal does not meaningfully delay the effect for most users.
- Are there risks involved in drinking alcohol? Small amounts may be tolerated, but excess alcohol can increase dizziness and reduce erectile performance.
- Tadalafil versus Cialis: both contain tadalafil. Cialis is the original brand licensed in the UK; Tadalafil is often a foreign-branded generic that may not be licensed locally.
- Is tadalafil safe for use by women? Tadalafil is not generally indicated for women.
- Will tadalafil raise testosterone? No. Tadalafil is not a hormone and does not increase testosterone levels.
- Can I import for personal use? Importing prescription-only medicines into the UK without a valid prescription risks seizure and is not recommended; see [UK status of lawful recognition.](#)
