Extra Super Tadarise: Mastercard Payment Options And How-To

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High level summary

Extra Super Tadarise is a combined oral tablet formulated for adult men that aims to address two common sexual health concerns in one dose: erectile dysfunction and premature ejaculation. It pairs a long-acting erection aid with a short-acting agent to delay ejaculation. Before using this product, go through the notes of a legal nature for Australia and obtain a medical assessment from a qualified prescriber.

- Primary symptoms include management of erectile dysfunction and reduction of premature ejaculation symptoms.

Core pharmacologically active ingredients and strength details

Each tablet of this fixed-dose formulation contains:

- Dapoxetine 60 mg amount
- Tadalafil 40 milligram dose

Excipients and packaging may differ by manufacturer. If you require a different strength, discuss the other possibilities in conjunction with your prescriber.

Planned application

When prescribed following a clinical evaluation, this combination may be used to improve erection quality and to extend the time to ejaculation. It is not intended for self-diagnosis or unsupervised long-term use. If you have not had a proper assessment, consult a clinician and probe the [safety implications to evaluate](#).

How it functions

- Tadalafil is a phosphodiesterase type 5 (PDE5) inhibitor that increases blood flow to the penis by relaxing vascular smooth muscle during sexual stimulation, supporting erection formation.

- Dapoxetine is a short-acting selective serotonin reuptake inhibitor (SSRI) that can improve voluntary control over ejaculation by enhancing serotonergic activity in the central nervous system.

Because the two drugs target different pathways, the combination can address both erection and ejaculatory control. Sexual stimulation remains necessary for tadalafil to produce an erection. Be sure to check every detail. for potential [the give and take of interactions at scale reveal systemic patterns.](#) and reasons to avoid this medication before you begin.

Safety safeguards and safeguards

Prior to starting Extra Super Tadarise, a clinician should review your full health history and medication list. Primary ideas to consider:

- Not for persons under 18 years. Older adults should receive individualized advice and monitoring and logging.
- Cardiac risk: sexual activity exerts cardiovascular demand. Seek clearance if you have unstable angina, recent myocardial infarction, uncontrolled arrhythmia, or severe heart failure.
- Blood pressure: the combination may cause symptomatic low blood pressure, particularly with other vasodilators or dehydration.
- Mental health and neurological conditions: use caution with histories of depression, bipolar disorder, mania, or seizure disorders; specialist input may be needed.
- Bleeding risks: dapoxetine can increase bleeding tendency; inform clinicians if you are on anticoagulants or have a bleeding disorder.
- Liver and kidney disease: severe impairment may require dose adjustment or avoidance.
- Urology issues: penile malformations or prior priapism episodes require urology assessment pre-use only.
- Sensory warning signs such as sudden vision or hearing loss require immediate discontinuation and urgent medical review.
- Avoid excessive alcohol because it can worsen dizziness and reduce treatment safety.
- Disclose all prescription, over-the-counter, herbal, and recreational substances to your prescriber to reduce potential hazards in the mutual influence during contact.

Dose amount and administration instructions

- Follow the prescription given by your healthcare professional and do not take more than recommended.
- Timing: typically take one tablet about 1 to 3 hours before expected sexual activity, unless directed otherwise by your prescriber.
- Administration: swallow the tablet whole with water; do not crush or chew.
- Food: it can be taken with or without food; heavy fatty meals may delay onset.
- Frequency: do not take more than one tablet in any 24-hour period.

Conditions that rule out its use

Do not take this product if any of the following apply:

- Known allergy to tadalafil, dapoxetine, or any excipient in the tablet.
- Concurrent use of nitrates, nitric oxide donors, or soluble guanylate cyclase stimulators (for example riociguat).
- Severe hypotension or significant orthostatic hypotension.
- Severely impaired liver function or severe renal impairment.
- Cardiac conditions where sexual activity is inadvisable.
- History of mania, bipolar disorder, or uncontrolled seizures.
- Active major bleeding or significant coagulopathy.
- Concurrent use of contraindicated medicines such as thioridazine or MAO inhibitors.
- Use of recreational nitrates such as amyl nitrite (poppers).
- Those who are younger than 18 years.

If you are not diagnosed with erectile dysfunction or premature ejaculation, do not use this product without a medical review. See also related links [Australian law a lay of the land for the number one spotic notes](#).

Additional effects

Extra effects can vary from mild to moderate to severe. Common and less common effects include:

- Common: ache in the head, flushing, nasal congestion, indigestion, back or muscle pain, nausea, dizziness, sleepiness.
- Less regular: decreased libido, excessive sweating, dry mouth, nosebleed, low blood pressure, vomiting.
- Serious signs requiring urgent care: chest pain, fainting, seizures, priapism (erection lasting more than 4 hours), sudden vision or hearing loss, or allergic swelling affecting breathing or swallowing.

Many medicines and substances interact with tadalafil or dapoxetine. Central communication in actions are the heartbeat of social platforms. to avoid or manage include:

- Absolute avoidance: nitrates, amyl nitrite, and riociguat because of the risk of dangerous drops in blood pressure.
- Antidepressants and psychotropics: combinations with MAO inhibitors are contraindicated; SSRIs, SNRIs, TCAs and some antipsychotics can affect serotonin balance and QT interval.
- Alpha-blockers and other antihypertensives: may produce additive blood pressure lowering; dosing strategies and real time monitoring may be needed.
- CNS depressants: combining with opioids, benzodiazepines, sedating antihistamines, sleep aids or alcohol may amplify drowsiness and dizziness.
- CYP3A4 inhibitors and inducers: strong inhibitors such as ketoconazole, itraconazole, clarithromycin, or ritonavir raise tadalafil exposure; inducers like rifampicin can reduce its effect.
- Grapefruit products: may increase tadalafil levels via CYP3A4 inhibition; avoid or consult your clinician.

- Other classes: some antibiotics, antifungals, anti-TB medicines and HIV therapies may require dose adjustments or constant monitoring.

Always provide a complete medicines list to your prescriber and pharmacist before the treatment starts. For accidental combinations or suspected toxicity see [deliberate overdose inducing actions](#).

What to do after missing your dose

This medication is typically taken as needed. If you miss an occasion, wait until the next time the medicine is required. Do not take extra tablets to cover a dose was missed.

Exceeding a safe dose management guidelines plan items

Taking more than the recommended amount can cause marked additional effects such as nausea, vomiting, agitation, flushing, dizziness, low blood pressure, chest pain, fast heart rate or prolonged erection.

- Stop taking the medicine immediately and seek urgent medical attention.
- In Australia, call emergency services or move in the direction of the nearest emergency department if you have chest pain or an erection lasting more than 4 hours (dial 000).

- Keep in the original blister pack or a tightly closed container at room temperature, typically 20 to 25 degrees C.
- Protect from excessive heat, moisture and direct sunlight.
- Keep this out of sight and away from children and pets.

Medicines that are similar and different choices

If a fixed-dose combination is unsuitable or unavailable, a prescriber may recommend single-agent therapy, paired prescriptions, or non-medicine approaches. Typical choice a backup routes include:

- Treatments and options for erectile dysfunction:
 - Tadalafil alone (Cialis or generics) for as-needed or low-dose daily use.
 - Sildenafil (Viagra or generics).
 - Vardenafil as marketed under Levitra and generic names.
 - Spedra (Avanafil) offering faster onset for some men.
 - Mechanical or procedural options such as vacuum erection devices or specialist-guided injections.
- Premature ejaculation care options:
 - Dapoxetine monotherapy where licensed in the market; check Australian registration status in [statutory notes](#).
 - Off-label SSRIs such as paroxetine, sertraline or fluoxetine when clinically appropriate.
 - Topical local anesthetics like lidocaine-prilocaine formulations.
 - Behavioral and pelvic floor therapies with trained clinicians.
- Combination strategies:
 - Your clinician may prescribe a PDE5 inhibitor plus a separate PE therapy tailored to your needs instead of a single fixed-dose tablet.
 - Other marketed combinations with different strengths exist in some countries; availability in Australia varies.

Choice depends on clinical history, concomitant medicines, tolerance for unintended effects and personal preference. See [price structure](#) when considering cost.

Prices shown in AUD as an indication

Prices are estimates only and vary by supplier, brand, pack size and whether purchased locally or from overseas. Typical per-tablet ranges in Australian dollars:

- Extra Super Tadarise 40 mg + 60 mg (overseas online sources): approximately AUD 6 to AUD 12 per tablet.
- Tadalafil 20 mg generic: about AUD 1.50 to AUD 4 per tablet online; branded Cialis in Australian pharmacies often costs AUD 15 to AUD 25 per 20 mg tablet.

- Sildenafil 50 to 100 mg generic: roughly AUD 1 to AUD 3 per tablet online; branded Viagra may be AUD 15 to AUD 20 per tablet.
- Avanafil 100 to 200 mg: commonly AUD 8 to AUD 20 per tablet in Australia depending on brand and pharmacy.
- Dapoxetine 30 to 60 mg (where available overseas): commonly AUD 3 to AUD 6 per tablet.

These figures do not include shipping, consultation, dispensing or customs fees. Always confirm current prices with your pharmacy or prescriber prior to purchase.

Australian law and regulatory highlights

- Prescription only: tadalafil and sildenafil are Schedule 4 medicines in Australia and require a valid prescription for lawful supply.
- Dapoxetine status: as of the time of writing, dapoxetine is not registered with the TGA for supply within the Commonwealth of Australia. Fixed-dose combinations containing dapoxetine are generally not stocked by Australian pharmacy networks.
- Personalized Importation Scheme: importation for personal therapeutic use may be possible under TGA rules if:
 - The medicine is for you or an immediate family member and is not prohibited.
 - No more than a three month supply arrives at one time merged with the total supply does not exceed the allowed limit.
 - You hold a valid Australian prescription for the medicine where required.
 - The product arrives in original packaging with clear labeling and you retain documentation.
- Border and customs: declare medicines when required. Some substances are prohibited or require permits. Check current guidance from the TGA conjoined with the Australian Border Force before ordering overseas.
- Sporting rules: PDE5 inhibitors are not currently banned by major anti-doping authorities, but athletes should consult Sport Integrity Australia or their medical team and use appropriate notification or TUE processes if there is a need.
- Quality risks: medicines sourced from unverified international suppliers may not meet Australian quality standards. Prefer regulated supply channels and medical oversight.

- May I have an alcoholic drink? Alcohol solution should be limited because it can increase dizziness in addition to the risk of fainting when combined with these medicines.
